INDEX TO THE ARCHBISHOP OF YORK'S MARRIAGE BONDS & ALLEGATIONS

1810 to 1819

This Index of Marriage Bonds and Allegations (Applications for Marriage without Banns) has been compiled by EB & WR Newsome and colleagues from the York Family History Society from the documents held at The Borthwick Institute of Historical Research, St Anthony's Hall, York.

The Archbishop of York granted marriage licences for the Diocese of York and also the remainder of the northern province when more than one jurisdiction was involved. Generally it seems that for the ten years 1810 to 1819 grants of licences were confined to people marrying within the Diocese or within the Archbishop's peculiar jurisdiction of Hexhamshire. The Diocese of York at that time included most of Yorkshire with the exception of the Deanery of Boroughbridge and the Archdeanery of Richmond which became part of the new Diocese of Chester in 1541. At the times when Nottinghamshire was in the Diocese of York a different situation arose. Marriage Licences were granted from two main sources:-

- (a) The Dean & Chapter of York through his peculiar jurisdiction over certain Nottinghamshire parishes. Details of the parishes concerned and a full list of the licences granted are contained in the Index to The Dean & Chapter's Marriage Bonds and Allegations 1613 - 1839. The Bonds are held in York.
- (b) The Archdeacon of Nottingham who issued the majority of licences in Nottinghamshire. The Bonds are held in Nottingham.

Normally, the Archbishop of York only issued licences in the cases where a man residing elsewhere in the Diocese applied to marry a woman residing in Nottinghamshire in her own parish church. Working back on the Index from 1839 it has become apparent that due to some local circumstance, there has been a period in each decade when the Archbishop has assumed responsibility for the issue of licences in Nottinghamshire. In this Index he issued more than 100 licences in 1817 and for some researchers in the Nottinghamshire area these are likely to be the missing links in their chain.

Only one licence for marriage outside the Diocese was granted in this decade and that was to Matthew Wilton at All Saints, Newcastle on Tyne.

The list of Churches/Chapelries named for the ceremony on the next pages will provide a broad indication of the area covered by the Index. There are also details of abbreviations used for churches/parishes etc and of the indicators used in the Index. The city of Kingston upon Hull is referred to as Hull throughout the Index.

The issue of a Marriage licence is not evidence of marriage and it is necessary to check the register of the Church/Chapel named, to confirm that the marriage took place.

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
